PHOTOGRAPHY CLASS

PHOTOGRAPHY CLASS

William Ortega, Photography Instructor: *While teaching community photography summer classes for Young Audiences over the past 8 years I have developed ways to introduce basic photography concepts, historical references and editing techniques that require little use of computer software. I introduce students to the view camera (one of the earliest versions of a camera) and its functions which really get to the basic elements and heart of photography (light, composition, focus, aperture and shutter speed). I have a working view camera that I bring in for students to use.*

Digital Negatives: Portraiture with Alternative Photographic Process:

Day 1- INTRO

After formalities: Students will be introduced to the process of capturing light in traditional means and its digital equivalent. The lesson will begin with a brief history of the discovery of modern photography, a history in making images and its significance today. Students will then be provided with basic lesson of exposure introducing the camera obscura, and exposure triangle for manual controls (Shutter/ISO/ Aperture). Some website links and handouts will be provided.

Day 2- FIRST SHOOT

Students will be shown a short video on what a cyanotype looks like and provided with instructions on how to prepare paper for cyanotype solution. They will be given two full 11x14" sheets of watercolor paper and two types of brushes (chip and sponge) as well as masking tape for diverse methods of applying emulsion. While half of the class prepares cyanotype paper the rest of the class will begin to learn how to use a digital SLR camera with natural and artificial lighting and some may begin to shoot a portrait of a classmate.

Day 3- SECOND SHOOT

The instructor will provide an inkjet printer and begin to print digital files into digital negatives and demonstrate the process. The 2nd half of students will then begin to coat paper with liquid emulsion and the instructor will give a shooting lecture to second half of group. Some will shoot portraits.

Day 4- THIRD SHOOT

This week, if needed, the class will conclude the portraits and some will begin to expose their negatives to coated paper using UV Lightbox and glass proofs.

Day 5- REFLECTION

The instructor will present all cyanotype prints and discuss with the group how they perceive the images as individual works and how they "read" as a whole. The instructor will open the conversation about their thoughts of the process and the results they managed to get, then lead a conversation about portraiture photography its history and the relationship between photographer and sitter and their personal experience with the process.
