Proclamation

WHEREAS, the honorable Margaret Tomczuk, 87, passed away on Tuesday, May 27th at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital in New Brunswick; and

WHEREAS, she was born in Alabama, resided in Carteret for many years; and

WHEREAS, she served our country during World War II in the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, she was the former Mayor of Carteret, having served from October to December 1982, and was also involved in the Carteret VFW along with the American Legion; and

WHEREAS, Margaret was predeceased by her husband and former Mayor of Carteret, John V. Tomczuk and also her son, John V. Tomczuk II; and

WHEREAS, she is survived by two children; Patricia Felauer of Jamesburg along with Barbara Tomczuk-Gschossmann and her husband Franz J. of Martinsville; and

WHEREAS, Margaret is also survived by two grandchildren; Jamie Felauer and Margot Gschossmann and a great grandchild; Brittany Felauer; and

WHEREAS, she and her family were honored as the namesake of "Tomczuk Courts" at Carteret Park in November 2009; and

WHEREAS, Margaret Tomczuk will be henceforth remembered as a model citizen of Carteret and Middlesex County, a loving family member and devoted parishioner, and a proud part of our local history;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DANIEL J. REIMAN, Mayor of the Borough of Carteret, do hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

1. That the flag of the United States of America and the flag of New Jersey shall be flown at half-staff at all Borough government buildings and facilities, from Friday May 30, 2014, through Monday, June 2, 2014, in recognition and mourning of Margaret Tomczuk.

2. That this Order shall take effect immediately.
